Civilian Equivalent for ANG:

- Labor opened a discussion concerning the military training and rank requirements (IAW AFI 21-101) that currently restrict technicians from accomplishing tasks for which they have received adequate training while in civilian status.
- Factors discussed include the following:
 - Checking off military training requirements from the member's CFETP after training received in technician status
 - The consistent availability of someone who meets the requirements to complete the tasks for the technician
 - The specifications and requirements needed to provide a waiver
 - Only hiring technicians who have achieved the military training and rank which allows them to accomplish the tasks in the technician PD/Job Standard
 - The Air-PEC decision to sign off training records as technicians are trained
 - Management continues to disagree with the Air-PEC decision based on AFI 21-101
- A motion was made that the regulation be sent to Air-PEC requesting a civilian equivalent be added for ANG clarification.
