Item

Status

1. Previous Minutes & LPC Metrics

Ongoing

The minutes were reviewed and accepted. The metrics were reviewed. All LPC's are meeting timely with quorum. Open and recently closed issues were discussed. AASF2-06-02 is still in progress. Expect construction to begin next year. LPC need to project dates for future meetings. The LRS will post those to the meeting metric slide.

2. Overdue Appraisals

Ongoing

The list of employees with overdue appraisals was reviewed. The council noted that employees assigned to USPFO are showing overdue on the by-name list but are not included in the overall roll-up of overdue appraisals. Further clarification may be required to determine who is responsible for ensuring these appraisals are accomplished.

3. Energy Conservation

Standing Item

LTC Zecchini gave a presentation on Energy Conservation. The Adjutant General's Department, Army and Air, is 20% below the Governor's goal. The Army is only 19% below the goal. The specific reasons we are succeeding are due to modernization of lighting, temperature controls and keeping large doors closed. Further reductions will come through utilization of alternative energy sources and newer, more efficient facilities. The council was reminded that the energy policy is signed, published and available on TAGNET.

4. Safety Issue Update

Standing Item

There were no significant safety issues presented since the last meeting. The Facilities Maintenance Sub-working Group is working to resolve a couple RAC II deficiencies but neither is expected to present an issue. Labor and management will meet to develop a consolidated metric for this sub-working group. The LRS will publish those metrics and meeting minutes on the Partnership webpage. The next meeting is scheduled for 9 December 2009.

5. *SMO LPC Meeting*

Update

The SMO LPC co-chairs, SMO leadership, labor leadership and the LRS met on 22 October. They discussed LPC membership, by-laws and the content of meeting minutes. The LPCs have amended their minutes as required and educated the LPC members on these processes. The LPC co-chairs will continue to work on their by-laws.

6. *Surface Maintenance Transformation*

Update

Management briefed the council on the current status of FMS's 1, 13, and 14; Mansfield, Springfield and Piqua respectively. The group was presented with a timeline of future events. Management briefed the activities of the SMO Road Ahead working group and presented an action plan. The action plan outlines the projects labor and management are working on regarding surface maintenance transformation. This working group meets monthly at a minimum and all agree their hard work is producing positive results.
